- Certificate of competence (RYA Level 2 / RYA PWC Proficiency / RYA ICC Power
- Craft certificate of insurance
- Towing / launching vehicle certificate of insurance.
- Proof of club membership
- 2 passport size photographs
- Stamped self-addressed envelope.
- Appropriate fee payable to Safe Water Commercial Services Limited via Credit Card / Cash

Please note that permit applications will not be processed unless all the above documentation is provided.

Notes for filling in Vehicle, Launching & Recovery Permit Application

Photographs

- 2 passport type photographs are required for all Vehicles, Launching & Recovery Permits.

Certification

- All PWC/Jet-ski riders are required to hold the RYA Personal Watercraft Certificate of Proficiency and must produce the **original certificate** when making their application for a Vehicle, Launching & recovery Permit.
- All recreational & commercial powered craft users are required to hold the RYA Level 2 National Powerboat Certificate or its equivalence and must produce the **original certificate** when making their application for a Vehicle, Launching & recovery Permit.
- Postal applications must contain copies of the following: **Certificate of Proficiency, Vehicle Insurance Certificate, Craft / Vessel Insurance Certificate**, and a stamped addressed envelope.

Name of Club or Association

- This information is essential for the maintenance of our records and passing on of information. **Proof of club membership** will be required to qualify for the appropriate discount.

Purpose for access

- Recreation includes recreational fishing, diving, racing boats, water skiing, PWC.
- Only tick commercial if the operator is making their living in total or part from their activities e.g. As a registered fisherman. Please note that copies of **Certificate of Proficiency, Vehicle Insurance Certificate, Craft / Vessel Insurance Certificate / IFCA Card and Company Tax information will be required.**

Authorised Slipways for PWC's/Jet-Skis and Powered Craft

- PWC's/Jet-Skis are restricted to Victoria Road South, New Brighton [No.3].
- All powered craft or vessels other than PWC's/Jet-Skis are restricted to Victoria Road South, New Brighton [No.3], Moreton Embankment [No.7] and Dove Point, Meols [No.8].

Restricted Slipways

- Harrison Drive [No.6]... sailing boats only.
- Dee Lane, West Kirby [No.14]..... Hilbre Tenants and Cockling only.
- Sandy Lane, West Kirby [No.17] .. unpowered Craft only.
- Thurstaston [No.15]..... Dee Sailing Club, Commercial Fishing, and access to moorings only.
- Banks Road, Heswall [No.16] access to moorings and unpowered craft only.

Access to the following slipways by special permission only:

Egremont [No's 1&2], Victoria Road North, New Brighton [No.3], Portland, New Brighton [No.5], Sand Heys, Meols [No.9], Hoyle Road, Hoylake [No.10], Trinity Road, Hoylake [No.11], Kings Gap, Hoylake [No.12], Stanley Road, Hoylake [No.13]. Under normal circumstances, these slipways will be kept locked.

Declaration of Insurance

- All applicants are required to sign a declaration to confirm that they have the appropriate insurance for both vehicle and craft. Permit applications will **NOT** be processed unless accompanied by proof of current insurance.
